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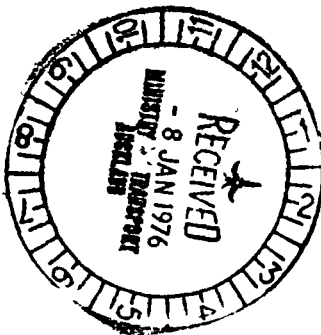

I must apologise for the delay in replying, but I have purposely put off actioning of this matter in the chance that I may have had to visit the area on other business. You can appreciate the fact that the expense both in my time and in travelling expenses would certainly not warrant a special inspection trip to the area for the sake of a request to remove eight cubic metres of sand and shingle.

I have perused N.Z. Island map Series No. 39/6 and find that the majority of the area in question appears to have a relatively wide beach frontage. This being the case, I would be inclined to give my approval for this removal, provided that it was made clear that no excavation should be made deeper than approximately six inches.

Needless to say, I will inspect the area at my first opportunity to combine the trip with other business, to ensure that the applicant is complying with the above.

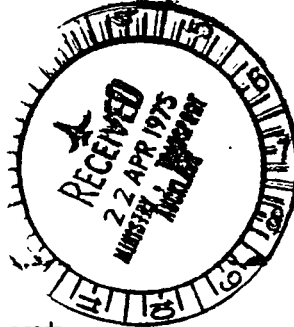

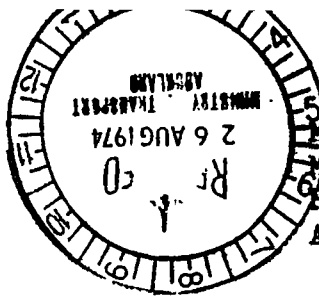



MR WHITEHOUSE : ISLAND VIEW LODGE

My resident engineer at Paeroa has advised that Waitete Bay was inspected on 31 January 1973 and that the build up of sand and shingle in the bay was greater than noted on any previous inspection over the past four years.

At half tide the bay was an even sloped area of sand and shingle approximately 350 yards long and 30 to 40 yards wide with rock reefs visible only at each end of the bay. Below half tide the sea floor dipped sharply from the sand and shingle to the normal bed rock and stony sea bed.

Changing weather conditions and tides can alter beach levels in Waitete Bay. North to north easterly storm conditions could remove up to two feet of material from all or part of the beach and following steady west to southwest conditions could replace some or alter the slope on the beach by building material up at the H.W.M. without covering the bed rock and stony sea bed at half tide level.

The quantity of ten cubic yards is insignificant in relation to the volume of material moved by the sea and I confirm my previous recommendation for renewal of the permit.
