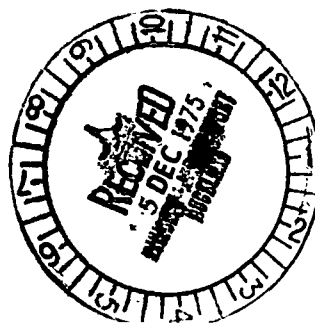

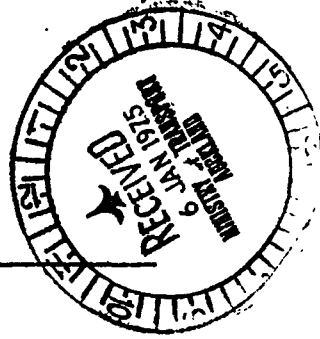

# LICENCE TO TAKE MATERIAL

Pursuant to the Harbours Act 1950

No 2570

To Mr. J. G. Jones

Address: 15, St. John's Road, 15

You are hereby authorised on payment of a licence fee of 10s. (\$1), and subject to the terms and conditions set out below, to take and remove 15 cubic yards per annum of \*stone, shingle, sand, boulders, silt, mud, from an area of the \*foreshore below high-water mark, harbour, river bed, bed of the sea, described as 15, St. John's Road, 15.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. This licence shall expire on the 31st day of December 1975 unless sooner revoked in terms hereof.

2. The licensee shall pay to the Marine Department a royalty of all material taken and removed at the rate of 20 cents per cubic yard.

\*3. The licensee shall, on the first day of each month, produce for inspection to his cargo book and official log book as required by section 177 of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, and shall thereupon pay all amounts (if any) due to date, or

\*4. The licensee shall, on the first day of each (month\*) (or of the quarters commencing in January, April, July, and October\*), produce to Ministry of Transport at Government Shipping Office a record of all material removed each day during the preceding (month\*) (or quarter\*), or, if no material has been removed during that period, advise him in writing accordingly, and shall thereupon pay all amounts (if any) due to date.

5. The licensee shall not remove any material from any place which, although included in the area above described, is used in whole or in part as a public road or highway.

6. The licensee shall not assign or subcontract out the benefit of this licence.

7. This licence may be revoked upon one week's written notice to the licensee at the above address and without notice if:

(a) The Department considers damage is being done or is likely to be done to adjacent land, or

(b) If the licensee, his servants, or agents shall fail to observe any term or condition hereof

without in any event prejudice to other rights of the Department including its right of recovery of payments due hereunder.

8. Further conditions: The licensee shall not use the material for any purpose other than that for which it was taken.

## Shingle Removal : Falcon Bay, Colville Harbour

1. An inspection of Colville Bay and Falcon Bay on 20 November 1974 showed an increase of shingle on areas that have previously been worked.
2. (a) Attached are copies of Mr. J. Goudie's sketch map showing in red where shingle deposits have increased since the last inspection in 1973. Also the approximate position of Mrs. G. Goudie's cottage is hatched in on the Falcon Bay sketch (b). The shingle spur on the Falcon Bay sketch has been extended in broken lines to show the area of shingle above half tide level when inspected on 20 November 1974. (c) The area shaded red was paced out and estimated to contain 300 c.yds shingle above the half-tide level.
3. Approval of Mr. J. Goudie's application is recommended providing he advises that his requirements for 1975 will be 150 c.yds, as per clause 3 of the attached report. Application forms are returned herewith.

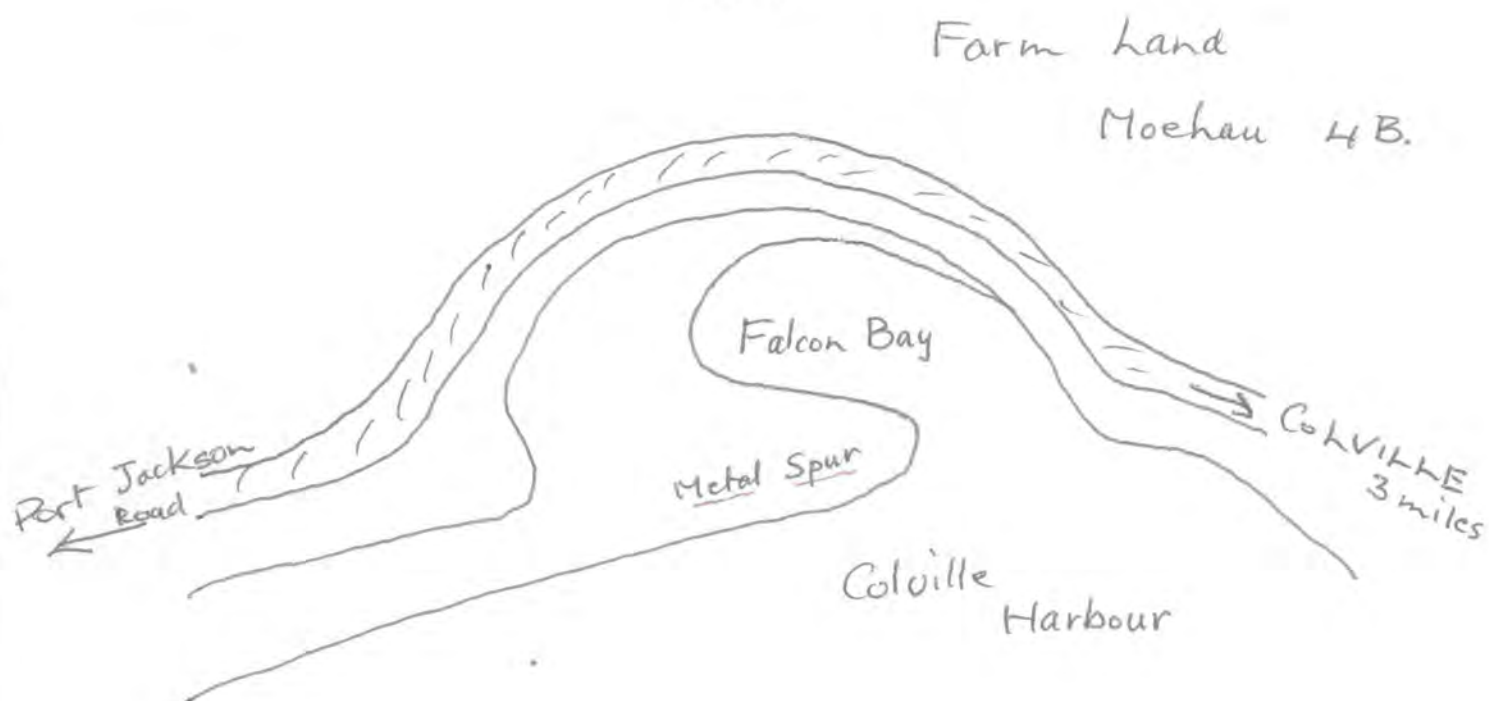


PLAN OF AREA SOUGHT FOR REMOVAL OF MATERIAL

Shingle Removal : Falcon Bay, Colville Harbour

1. The complaint from Mr. J.N. Webb has not been sighted to date but the Marine Division reply, memo 54/4/7/34 of 11 November 1974, plus our previous correspondence attached 7/2 of 29 May 1972, supplies sufficient information to appreciate the problem.

It is apparent that the cottage owners rent part of the road reserve from the Coromandel County. The conditions of rental and area involved are not known but it is difficult to understand how the occupiers can prohibit access to the foreshore within a public road reserve.

2. There was no evidence of holes having been left along the foreshore on 20 November 1974. There was evidence on the bed of Falcon Bay (which is about 1½ feet above M.L.W.M.) of tractor wheel marks where a loader had been loading from the back of the shingle spur. The unnatural shape of the spur indicated that approximately 60 to 80 cyds of shingle had been removed over the last two months. This is the area from where J. Goudie normally removes shingle and any temporary holes below or stockpile mounds above M.H.W.M. would in no way affect the level shingle or grassed areas westward from the shingle spur around and past the cottage.

3. The amount removed was discussed with Mr. J. Goudie who admitted he had taken more than 30 cyds of shingle during 1974. He also advised that he understood the application form M.O.T. 5907 he signed on 6 November 1974 was for additional quantities to the end of the calendar year 1974.

He was asked to advise Marine Division of the amount removed during 1974 and to clarify that his requirements for 1975 would be 150 cyds of shingle.

4. During discussions on alternative supplies of shingle for J. Goudie in 1972 the County Engineer suggested Melsop's Crossing deposits on the Urarimu Stream approximately four miles north. Mr. Goudie objected mainly on the grounds that Melsop's shingle was clean hard stone that failed to compact and damaged the hoofs of cattle and sheep. He suggested the shingle deposits in Colville Bay about half a mile east of Falcon Bay at N.Z.M.S. reference 959892, marked on the attached sketch as (2).

This deposit is soft material similar to Falcon Bay shingle and when inspected on 20 November 1974 contained 400 to 500 c.yds of shingle which could be used as an alternative supply if access to Falcon Bay is prohibited.

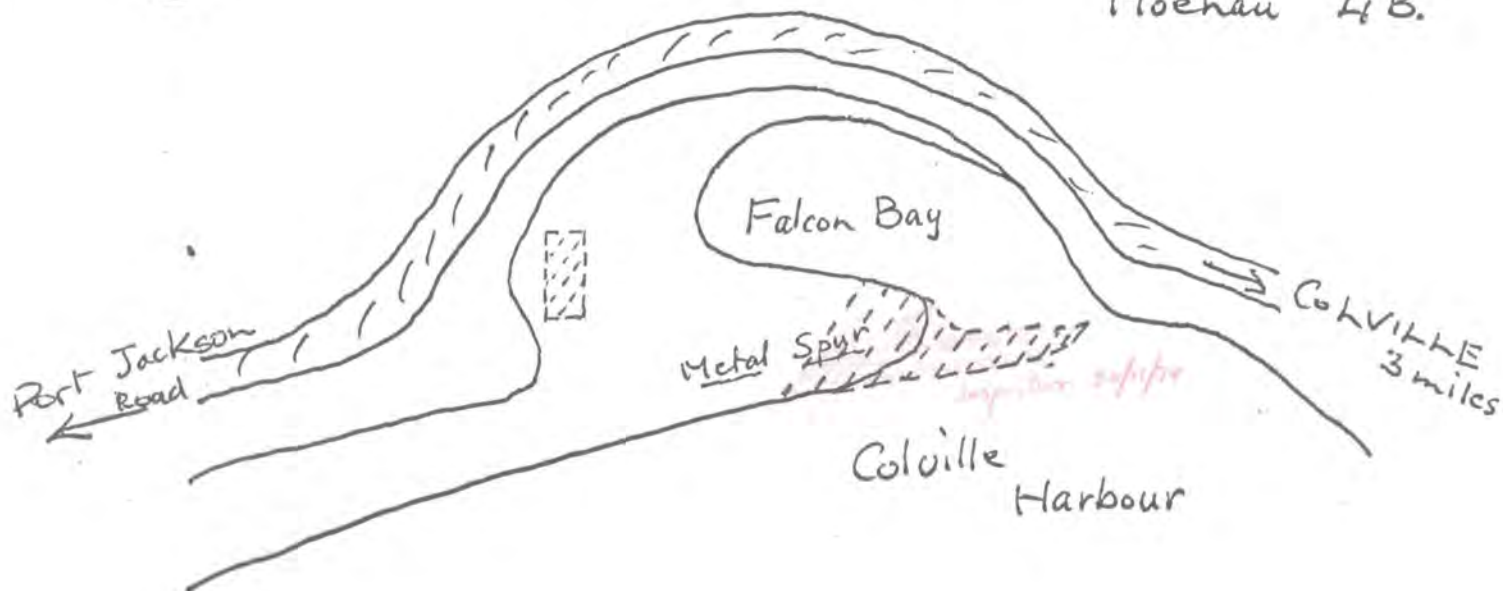

Shingle Removal : Colville

1. In regard to your letter of 22 May the position is as follows :
- (a) Mr. J. Goudie applied to the Marine Department for a permit to remove shingle at a rate of 250 cubic yards per annum from below mean high water mark.
  - (b) The Marine Department requested a report from the Ministry of Works as their advisers in such matters.
  - (c) The area was inspected by my Inspector of Works, Mr. Keegan, in company with the County Engineer.
  - (d) It was decided that there had been an accretion of shingle over recent years and that this build up was likely to continue. Therefore the removal of a small quantity each year would have no adverse effect.

It was therefore recommended to the Marine Department that a licence be issued subject to an annual inspection, with provision for cancellation of the licence if such inspection showed any adverse effect.

In making this recommendation Mr. Keegan stated that quantities of up to 500 or 600 cubic yards could possibly be taken per annum without ill effect. However, I would expect that the Marine Department will have issued a licence for only the 250 cubic yards per annum.

2. You speak of Mr. Goudie taking shingle for filling on a large scale. I have no way of knowing what you mean by this term. To you 250 cubic yards mean a large scale. On the other hand, it is possible that Mr. Goudie has exceeded the terms of his licence and by a large scale you mean something well in excess of the 250 cubic yards. If the latter is the case, and you can prove it to be so, then I think you have very good cause for lodging a complaint with the Marine Department (The District Officer, Marine Department, Auckland).


3. If Mr. Goudie has not exceeded the terms of his licence, and does not do so before the end of the twelve month period, then I think we can only wait and see what an inspection then shows. If the material removed has not been replaced by natural accretion then we would recommend that the licence be terminated, or the amount to be taken annually be reduced.

4. From your letter it appears as though you have built your house on road reserve, or other public reserve. I must say that I find this a very strange arrangement, and one that only asks for trouble in one way or another. However, that is by the by.

5. I will send a copy of this letter, and your letter, to both the Marine Department and the County Council so that they are aware of the situation.





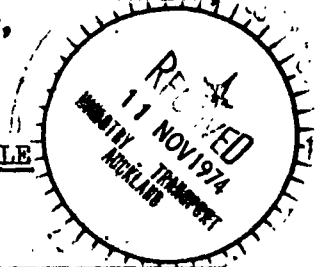

Thank you for your letter of 29.10.74 and wish to advise that Mr J. Goudie has been issued a removal licence from this Ministry in recent years. This licence is renewable annually and is subject to an annual inspection by our Technical Advisors to ensure that no damage occurs to the foreshore and that the material removed is from a replaceable source.

While it is regretted that Mr Goudie uses the property of Mrs G. H. Goudie to gain access to the beach this is a matter outside the control of this Ministry and some remedy must lie in the hands of the owners of the land.

A check of the returns supplied by Mr Goudie would indicate that to date during the currency of the present licence which is for 30 cubic yards of shingle per annum, shows that no removals have been made and it may be that material is being removed by some other person or persons.

However a report on the condition of the beach will be requested from our Technical Advisors and should in their estimation the removal of material be considered detrimental to the foreshore cancellation of the licence will be considered.

A letter will also be sent to Mr Goudie requesting that he find some other area to place his tractor to cause the minimum of inconvenience to residents in the area.


