

Please be advised that resulting from a favourable report from our Technical Advisers on receipt of \$1.00 being issue fee, a licence will be issued authorizing your Company to remove a total of 764 cubic meters (1000 cubic yards) of sand from the above area as shown on the enclosed plan.

It should be noted that removal of sand from the above area should only be done from the area specified and the sand removed to a regular depth over the area to eliminate holes appearing in the beach. The removal of sand should also be taken on a regular basis to avoid denuding the foreshore of material and the licence issued will be so endorsed.

Your attention is drawn to the fact that all returns of material are to be made in cubic meters and payment for material removed will be at the rate of \$0.36 per cubic meter. This increased royalty is partly due to the conversion from cubic yards to cubic meters and also to the decision of the Minister of Transport that royalties for all material removed from the foreshore be increased to cover administration expenses etc.



Approval of A A Simpsons application and continued periodical inspection of the Knaptumu foreshore is recommended.

This does not, however, suggest that we are entirely egreeable to allowing: Simpsons, and any such other applicant, to remove sand as and when required. Rether, it stems from the fact that an inspection of the foreshore on 17 February 1975 and on many previous occasions showed no evidence of any detrimental effects from present and past sand removals.

It is elso to be noted that the amount of sand required by the applicant for this, and the following year, is in line with my recommendation of paragraphyl of my 7/2 of 2 July 1974. That is, a limit of 1,000 cubic yards per annum per applicant. Furthermore, it is expected that the total sand removal requirements by all interested parties for the current year, will be well within the maximum of 3,000 cubic yards as recommended in my same memo.







- M.H. Keegan on the above subject. This clarifies the question of the stability of the beach which you raised in your memo.
 - You state that Hodge and Simpson have both indicated that they could require twice the amount indicated in their applications, and that the total removal for the year could be 3,700 cubic yards. I cannot see where you have gained this information. Are you perhaps confusing the fact that Simpson, for example, has stated that he may wish to remove a further 1,000 cubic yards in the following calendar year (i.e., answer to question 9 on application form). If so, then the total figure for this year will be, as indicated by Mr. Reegan, either 2,100 or 2,600 cubic yards net 3,700.
 - 3. While Mr. Keegan has kept a close observation over the years of the behaviour of this beach, and his remarks regarding the removals being only a small fraction of the natural changes which take place are correct, I am concerned about two aspects:
 - (i) When a large area is being considered then it only requires a small difference in depth to represent a large quantity. Mr. Keegan cannot be expected to recall exactly the level at some time in the past. There therefore could be some small nett decrease in the sand on the beach over a period of several years, despite there having been bigger increases and decreases during those years. Only a careful measurement of the beach on a regular basis could determine this.
 - (ii) Even if the beach is maintained at the same level over a long period of years the question arises as to where the sand comes from to replenish that taken away under permit. It may be that the sea bed is being replenished by sand from rivers and this balances or more than balances the emount removed from the beach. If this is so, there is no cause for concern about the current rate of removal. On the other hand it is possible that there is little or no replenishment from rivers, and that replenishment of the beach in question is being maintained at the expense of losses from other adjacent beaches, or from the sea bed below low water mark.

If the latter were the case then a gradual steepening of the bed may be occurring and this could be undesirable.

I do not have the resources to investigate either (i) or (ii) above, and in fact it may be impossible to establish for certain what is happening because of the relative smallness of the removals to the large amount of sand being carried to and fro constantly by natural forces.

4. I can only recommend that permits be limited to fairly small emounts per year and that a continuing watch be kept on the beach. In the absence of any firm data to go by I suggest that any one applicant be limited to a quantity of 1,000 cubic yards per annum, and the total by all parties to 3,000 cubic yards per annum in the meantime. It may be possible, or necessary, to revise these figures some time in the future.

- 5. Accordingly, it is recommended that Simpson be granted a permit for an additional 500 cubic yards this year, making a total of 1,000 cubic yards for the year.

Sand and Shingle Removal Area, Knaotunu

- Sand removals at Kuaotunu are restricted to 460 yards of foreshore adjacent to the Pitoone Stream mouth. The area extends from the sand dunes just west of the Pitoone Stream Bridge on the Bluff Road, eastward to the low rock reefs below S.H. 25 ten chains south of the Bluff Road intersection. The width of the sandy beach above half tide level varies from 30 to 120 yards and would average about 50 to 70 yards. The half tide level has been adopted as the limit of the working area. The width of the beach between high and low water would vary from 20 to 70 yards according to the slope of the beach.
- 2. During February to April 1974 the Pitocne Stream mouth remained approximately in the 'blow-out' position and a large build-up of sand occurred eastward off the Bluff Road intersection where the width of the beach above half tide level exceeded 120 yards. The sand slope was steeper than usual in the half to full tide zone which measured 6 to 8 yards and the average sand level over the 112 to 114 yards of beach off Bluff Road intersection was about two feet above high water.
- 3. (a) Then inspected on 4 July 1974 the width of the beach over 460 yards of foreshore varied from 30 to 90 yards above half tide level showing an area of 25,000 to 26,000 square yards of sand and shingle.
- (b) The Pitcone Stream mouth was about 200 yards east of the 'blow-out' position and a deposit of clean evely graded sand had built up from the base of the sand dunes eastward for 180 yards over the 'blow-out' position. This deposit had built up to about two feet above normal beach level over an area of 2,200 square yards. The shoal appeared to be of recent deposit and contained about 1,500 cubic yards of sand. A recent sand removal hole in the shoal near the sand dune and showed the same clean sand at 3'6" deep.
- (c) The change in the position of the Pitoone Stream mouth and channel had reduced the width of the beach above high water to 50 yards off the Bluff Road intersection and lowered the beach level at the 100 yard wide mark by 5 to 6 feet below the February April level. The drop in beach levels, estimated at 2'6" over ACA of the total workable area, showed a movement of approximately 8,000 to 9,000 c.yds of sand and shingle from above half tide level in addition to the build-up of 1,500 c.yds of sand adjacent to the 'blow-out' area as in (b) above.
- 4. (a) During 1968, while beach levels were lower than when inspected on 4th July 1974, a period of north-easterly storms with high seas from 1st to 9th April 1968 caused further erosion of beach levels. The total workable area was lowered 2 to 5 feet below high water and normal high tide washed against S.H. 25 formation edge and started erosion from 5 to 12 chains east of Bluff Road intersection.

- (b) Beach levels remained low for a fortnight and then suddenly built up over a period of three days. The quantity of sand and shingle removed and replaced by sea action during April 1968 would exceed 30,000 cubic yards.
- 5. It is therefore apparent that the quantity of sand and shingle removed on licence is very small compared to the quantity periodically moved by the sea. It is also difficult to justify a restriction on removal of sand and shingle from an area that has remained stable with minor fluctuations over the past seven years.
- 6. The actual amount of sand and shingle removed since 1968 is not known but according to our files the following applications were recommended for approval:

- (c) There is no indication on Hodge's application of 24.12.73 or McQueens of 28.11.73 that greater quantities would be required the following calendar year.

Your letter of 19 February applying for a permit to take 250 yards of sand per month from Kuaotumu beach has been referred to me, as it had been incorrectly addressed by you to the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries.

Licences to remove sand, shingle or other materials from the Crown tidal land are granted under Section 146A of the Harbours Act 1950, but only after a favourable report has been received from our technical advisers, that no damage will be caused leading to erosing or an inroad of the sea, and that the material will be replaced by natural causes. It is an offence to remove material unless a current licence is held.

You should address your application to the Regional Marine Officer, Ministry of Transport, Auckland with as much detail as possible, for instance, what procedure is proposed for removing the material and from exactly what position or positions it is to be taken.

Removal of sand from this beach in the past has been severely restricted, and it is probable that annual licences for the full amount permitted have already been issued for this year.

Sand Permits : Kuaotunu Beach McQueens Transport

Your 47/16 of 26 August 1972 refers.

The area marked on the attached cadastrial map '10 is east of the Pitoone Street mouth and covers the foreshore from the intersection of S.W. 25 and Bluff Road eastward to the low rock reefs out from the greywacke quarry.

This is the area where sand removal from above high tide left large holes in the beach and caused adverse local comment.

The beach level in this area fluctuates with sterm and tide. Once during the last eight years the beach level dropped about eight feet during the storms of 1 to 9 April 1968 causing erosion of S.H. 25 formation. Normal high tide continued to wash against the highway formation for approximately a fortnight and then the beach sand built up to about normal level in three days. It is therefore possible the amount of sand removed for commercial use will have little effect on beach levels.

The sand that builds up on the landward side of the changing Pitoene Stream channel is evenly graded and suitable for commercial use. The sand of the seaward side of the channel changes as high tides or rough seas removes and deposits evenly graded sand or mixtures of sand and shingle in varying depths along the beach. There is a greater demand for evenly graded sand so by working both sides of the channel it would not be necessary to fossick along the seaward side for the grading of sand required.

The increase in this application plus the renewal of the two other permits approved for 1972 (i.e., Hodges and Simpson) would amount to the removal of 2,000 c.yds of sand per annum or about 45 c.yds per week of worked evenly throughout the year. Quantities removed would probably vary from nil to 180 c.yds per week.

In view of my comments in my report of 10 May I am loath to agree to taking of sand on the eastern side of Pitoone Stream but, on the basis of the discussion above, perhaps.

Permission could be granted on a trial basis to remove sand from both sides of the Piteone Stream channel as marked on the attached sketch on condition that:

(a) The area of beach being worked is restored to a natural appearance at the end of each day's work (i.e., no holes are left as was the case recently).

(b) Removals of sand cease during periods when beach levels are low and be restricted during build up to normal beach levels.

(c) McQueen's Transport be limited to taking no more than 500 c.yds per annum from the eastern side of the stream.

(d) When Hodges' and Simpson's permits come up for renewal they also be allowed to remove sand from the eastern side of the stream but with the quantity limited to 250 c.yds per annum each.
