SAND AND SHINGLE ROYALTIES REVISION.

The Minister of Marine has approved, pursuant to Section 146A of the Harbours Act 1950, a revision and simplification of the above royalties.

As from 1st September, 1967, except as in paragraph 3, royalties payable for the removal of all materials from Crown foreshores or the beds of navigable rivers or the sea are to be standardised. The royalties are to be 20 cents per cubic yard, but for materials dredged from below Low Water mark of the sea they are to be 10 cents per cubic yard, in view of the special equipment - barges, tugs etc. required.

When it is apparent that the total quantity of material available for removal, as recommended by the Ministry of Works, cannot reasonably be allocated by licence to more than one Contractor, the Secretary for Marine or Superintendent of Mercantile Marine may, if he wishes, call for tenders in relation to the royalty to be charged, and accept the highest tender from a reputable Contractor.

All previous Ministerial notices are cancelled.
