





I enclose for your record a copy of the approved plan which has been numbered and marked "Copy of MD(N)435". Although this plan has been approved, when investigating the application our technical advisers raised some points which still remain to be settled. However, we would like to be sure that the construction of the wharf will be under the direct control of your office and that it will be in accordance with the approved plans. With your letter of 14 December 1977, you forwarded plans (two sheets) showing various modifications which have been done to the structure. One thing which was noted on these plans was that there was the inclusion of a set of steps on the "T" section of the jetty. These were not shown on the plans that have been approved and if they are to be constructed further plans will need to be forwarded showing the detail of the structure.

We have made a condition on the plan approval to ensure that vessels of 10 tonne would not use the wharf and we note in your letter of 14 December that this restriction will be enforced by Council Officers. We would be grateful if you would stringently enforce this condition as we are concerned that the wharf is not of sufficient strength to survive any buffeting which may occur if a vessel of greater tonnage was to use the wharf, thereby causing possible danger to the structure, the vessel, or persons on the wharf.

We will shortly be issuing your Council a licence for the jetty as shown on plan MD(N)435 however if steps are to be included in the structure would you please forward plans showing the details of the steps to this office at the earliest opportunity. If plans of the steps are delayed, it will necessitate an amendment to the licence at an early date. I will put this matter under

Bring-up for a period of six weeks from the date of this letter and if I have not heard from you I will proceed to have a licence drawn up using the above approved plan.



As you are no doubt aware this project has been held up for three years awaiting advice as to whether or not governmental financial assistance would be available on a subsidy basis. We have finally reached the stage where such finance is unlikely and in any case inflation is demolishing the value of the few funds we have in hand to finance this project.

Accordingly we have drastically reduced the standard of jetty to the enclosed sketch and we have a contractor available to commence work at an early date with nil financial assistance from your department.

Would you therefore kindly issue the licence at your earliest convenience to avoid further delays and inflation effects.

A licence is also needed to occupy Crown land and we will need to know who will be the "occupier" and therefore responsible for construction and future maintenance. I gather it will still be the Waitomo District Council in which case the annual rental is at a nominal rate. Were the structure to be exclusively for the use of club members and the licence issued to the club, a rental is charged on the basis of the size of the structure. A licence can incorporate a charge for use but there is always the difficulty of collecting from casual users. If there is concern that large boats might use the wharf and this is not desired, a "requirement" can be placed on the plans that a notice be erected which states that boats of "X size" are not permitted to use the jetty. If you see any administrative problems in controlling the use of the proposed jetty, perhaps you could raise these and we will be pleased to give further consideration and advise on ways of possibly overcoming any difficulties.

I also suggest that, if you wish, preliminary sketch plans be sent for initial comment. I gather that any shoreward area for adequate parking of cars or trailers and other amenities is already taken care of but you should confirm this as a back up to the environmental side of the effect of the jetty on the surrounding area.

I enclose an application form seeking occupation right by way of a foreshore licence. It also gives information on the reverse side appropriate to the plans. Final plans should be sent to the Regional Marine Officer, Ministry of Transport, Private Bag, Auckland.

TE WAITERE WHARF PROPOSAL: YOUR REFERENCE 78

I refer to your letter of 22 July in which you ask if a "reduced standard structure" would be acceptable. You qualified this by indicating this meant a smaller jetty suitable for the needs of the boat club and local recreational requirements.

However, I do wish to first comment on your opening remarks that "the cost of the wharf has reached this high figure because of the requirements of your Ministry before approving the construction plans".

I have examined our file and note that in 1973 your Council advised that the club had been in touch with consulting engineers. At that time you asked if we could provide minimum loading figures and other related matters.

We responded by advising that this was a responsibility of the conculting engineers who had been approached as we did not provide that information. We then mentioned our basic requirements for the plans and also indicated the club would be able to control the size of vessels using the wharf.

The next relevant correspondence was your response in forwarding plans and specifications for the facility then estimated by yourselves as costing \$30,000 (1973 figure). I am therefore unable to conclude where our requirements created the high cost figure.

Concerning your enquiry about a smaller structure, this Ministry is clearly not in a position to determine what size jetty is needed. This obviously is the prerogative of the proposer who would be building a facility to meet particular needs in a particular locality.

Where this Ministry is involved is in the appraisal of the plans to ensure a particular structure would not be or tend to be to the denger of navigation and that plans be adequate to show the method of construction, location and so forth.

I am pleased to advise that the plan of the above structures has been approved pursuant to Section 178(b) of the Harbours Act 1950 and endorsed on plan numbered MD(N)44.

Enclosed is a copy of the approved plan marked "Copy of MD(N)44".

Our technical advisers when reporting on the proposal have stated that in respect of the wharf the following points:

- 1. It is presumed that there will be some structural restriction to stop vehicular traffic moving on to the wharf.
- That consideration should be given to the providing of raker piles for the wharf and
- 3. That precautions should be taken to prevent the corrosion of any exposed steel work on the structure.

The approval of these plans is not indicative that finance is available from government, this having been the subject of earlier correspondence.

As the wharf and ramp are located on Crown foreshore, it will be necessary for this office to issue a licence pursuant to Sections 162 and 265A of the Harbours Act 1950. Under memo 54/1/398 of 19 March 1975 the Auckland office of Marine Division has forwarded the enclosed plans of the Waitomo County Council number 375 sheets 1 and 2. The plans have earlier been submitted and you made various structural comments in your memo of 1 October 1974.

It is considered that the plans made be approved from a navigational point of view. In respect to the strucutral requirements there are no raker piles and it is felt that the exposed steelwork is undesirable for the long term safety of the structure. 

TE WAITERE WHARF AND BOAT RAMP /

The wharf, the boat ramp, and the sea-wall as shown on the Plan 375 will not cause any undue interference to harbour traffic, affect the flow of tides or currents, nor will it unduly affect the environment of the area and therefore the proposal satisfies the general requirements of the Harbour Act of 1950.

As pointed out in my reply to the original proposal dated 24/4/74, the existing wharf structure has not had any detrimental affect on the surrounding harbour area and it is not envisaged that the new structures will alter the situation.

It is assumed that the estimate of \$30,000 referred to by Mr D. Annabell in his letter dated 20 June 1974, is in fact the same estimate that was forwarded with the original proposal. To this I would like to comment that the estimate is for the construction of only the new wharf and no mention is made of the removal of the existing wharf, and it is suggested that it be stipulated in any approval given that the whole of the existing structure be completely removed once the new wharf is built.

Further the estimate for the construction of the boat ramp quoted as \$5,000 on Plan 375 plus the cost of construction of the sea wall and related reclamation below the mean high water mark (no estimate given), would need to be included in any overall development cost.

It should be noted that the "Boat Ramp" will be required to have its own separate licence.

With respect to the wharf proposed on Plan 375, the following comments are considered pertinent:

- 1. The floating ramp, there is a conspicuous lack of detail shown relating to :
  - a) what makes it float.
  - b) what it is made of.
  - c) hinge details,
  - d) why it is necessary for the fender cap to be used for raising the floating ramp.
- 2. There is no indication of where, how, or if at all, bollards are to be part of the wharf structure, i.e. are boats meant to be able to "tie up" to the wharf?
- 3. With the single line of support columns, as shown, (20 ft clear of the rock layer), there is virtually no transverse stiffening and should the structure ever be struck by a barge, or large boat, serious deflections could occur. Twin piles at Pier 2 and at Pile A, B, and C positions would have eliminated this concern.
- 4. A handrail to stop people or objects from falling from the wharf and on to the floating ramp would have improved the safety aspect of the proposal.
- 5. It is presumed that there will be some structural restriction to stop vehicular traffic moving on to the wharf.
- 6. A light on the end of the wharf could be considered necessary and if so provision should be made now for placing the required power cable plus any other service that might be required in the future.
- 7. Approved facilities for diesel and petrol fuelling should be requested to minimise the risk of pollution.

It is recommended that subject to the above comments, approval in principle be given to the proposal.

Please refer to your latter of 17 December. The Ministry of Transport has no funds available for a subsidy of this nature and it would be necessary to apply for Cabinet approval.

In order to prepare a suitable submission and to obtain the support of Treasury it will be necessary to have much more information about this proposal. Some points were referred to in my letter to you of 29 October which you have not referred to in your reply.

It will first be necessary to establish the justification for a wharf at this site other than purely for recreational use by the boat club, that is to say who it will be used by and for what purpose, including potential future use. Having established the necessity for a wharf the Ministry must then examine the design, engineering plans and estimate to ensure that it is suitable for the proposed use and is the most economical and reasonable solution; this must include the use or removal of the old jetty.

The Council should then state how it proposes to finance the work. In order to encourage Treasury support, it must be shown that the maximum available amount of local funds has been raised for this local project. For instance, would it be feasible to make charges for the use of the wharf, and could they service a If so, for how much? It is understood from Mr K.T. Wetere M.P. that the club is prepared to contribute \$7000 and that Waipipi Ironsands Co. has indicated that it is prepared to contribute some finance, how much is not known. The submission for Government subsidy assistance must relate to the difference between an approved estimate and the maximum local contribution from all sources.

The technical examination of the plan and estimates will be carried out in our Auckland office and it is requested that you will send two copies to the Regional Secretary, Ministry of Transport, Private Bag, Auckland, for the attention of the Regional Marine Officer.
